

Hernández & Cía and Garrigues land Peruvian airport deal

Hernández & Cía Abogados has helped Peruvian investor Andino acquire 50% of the capital stock in local airport operator, Aeropuertos Andinos del Perú.

The seller, Corporación América Airports – the world’s largest private airport operator – turned to Garrigues (Peru).

The deal closed on 22 December for a confidential amount.

Through the share purchase agreement, Andino has become the sole owner of Aeropuertos Andinos.

Andino is a Peruvian holding company that manages a group of businesses that operate airports and ports. It is listed on the Lima stock exchange. At the end of 2021, Andino **acquired** shares in local port operator Cosmos Agencia Marítima from DP World Logistics, an Emirati multinational logistics company. Back in March, the group **structured** a US\$50 million investment fund that provides loans to local, mid-sized companies.
