

Several Peruvian firms land airport services deal

Estudio Echeopar member firm of Baker McKenzie International has helped local airport services group Talma acquire the remaining stake in its business from local private equity company Enfoca for US\$164 million.

The seller turned to Rodrigo, Elías & Medrano Abogados.

The buyer obtained an acquisition financing to fund the deal. For that transaction, Talma hired Philippi Prietocarrizosa Ferrero DU & Uria (Peru), while the lenders enlisted Hernández & Cía.

Both the acquisition and the financing closed on 11 April.

Grupo Sandoval – a Peruvian holding company and Talma's parent business – previously held a 51% interest in the airport services provider. Following the acquisition, Sandoval and its subsidiaries own the entirety of the airport group.

Talma operates at 20 airports in Peru. It has additional subsidiaries in Colombia, Ecuador and Mexico.
