

Peruvian airport gets cross-border loan

Three Latin American firms have helped Peruvian airport services provider Talma obtain a US\$135 million financing to repay existing debt.

Philippi Pietrocarrizosa Ferrero DU & Uría (Peru), Contexto Legal Abogados in Medellín and Pérez Bustamante & Ponce (PBP) in Quito advised Talma.

The lenders relied on Peruvian firm Hernández & Cía, Ecuador's Bustamante Fabara and Galicia Abogados in Mexico City.

Latin Lawyer understands that Garrigues (Mexico) and Colombian outfit Posse Herrera Ruiz advised the borrower and lenders, respectively, but this could not be confirmed before publication.

The financing closed on 10 June. It was secured by guarantees provided by the borrower's subsidiaries in Colombia, Ecuador and Mexico

The airport business will use the loan to repay the acquisition financing used to fund the US\$164 million purchase of the remaining stake in its business from local private equity company Enfoca. That acquisitions [closed](#) in April.

Talma operates at 20 airports in Peru.
