

Rebaza Alcázar and Hernández & Cía steer Peruvian fruit loan

Rebaza, Alcázar & De Las Casas has helped Peruvian fruit producer Agrícola Andrea secure a US\$25 million loan.

Hernández & Cía advised the lenders in the deal, which closed on 27 November.

Agrícola Andrea will use the proceeds from the loan to fund the repayment of its outstanding debt, as well as for general corporate purposes.

Agrícola Andrea was founded in 2003 and specialises in the cultivation of a range of fruits, such as blueberries and grapes. It has fields located in the district of Jayanca – which is within Peru's northwestern Lambayeque region – and the southern region of Ica. Earlier in November, the company [secured](#) a US\$19 million credit facility from Coöperatieve Rabobank, which formed a part of a wider financing transaction worth a total of US\$42 million.
